## Conditions of Entry

### ELIGIBILITY and ACCEPTANCE

- All riders and owners must be registered and financial with EA.
  - Horses must have a current EA competition license, be currently registered & financial with EA.
  - Maximum number of horses accepted in competitions will be dependent on time constraints.
  - Performances are not required at any level however combinations competing in FEI competitions must have met the qualification criteria in line with EA rule 4.8.3.2
  - Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis until the class is fully subscribed, subsequent entries will be placed on a reserve list. Entries that have performance at the level entered may be given preference.
  - The Organising Committee does have the right to make exceptions in special circumstances.
  - Competitions (CDN) will be held in accordance with the current EA Dressage Competition Rules & Procedures and EA Gen. Regulations.
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- **CDN-P:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 16.
  - **CDN-J:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 14 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 18.
  - **CDN-Y:** Open to riders from beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21.
  - **CDN Under 25 Tour:** Open to riders aged 16 to 25 years.
  - **Height:** Horses must have a height at the withers exceeding 149cms including shoes or 148cms without shoes; Ponies must not exceed 149cms with shoes or 148cms without shoes.

## Withdrawals

- Refunds: entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fees will be retained by the O.C. Entry fees will be refunded in full as soon as possible for scratchings before the closing date. Entry fees (inc. stabling/camp/ etc not used) for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition will be refunded after the event. Refunds for stables and camping will not apply for riders who decide to leave early. Any refund requested before the closing date will incur a 20% processing fee.
- The administration fee will not be refunded.

## Freestyles

- A combination must score a minimum of **60%** at their respective level to be eligible.
- For CDN P, CDN J and CDN Y, this is in the Individual test.
- For Advanced and Medium tour, minimum may be achieved in either test.
- The OC reserves the right to amend minimum requirements.
- Numbers accepted will be limited.
- **Freestyle Music:** Competitors will be advised how to upload music to a website for easy download and storage by event organisers. Music will be tested by our sound technician
  - Music testing times will be allocated, only Grand Prix competitors will be given a mounted practice time.

## Special Information Relating to Young Horse Competitions

- Entry fees for the Young Horse include both rounds.
- To be run under the Australian State Championships formula. Both rounds may be used as qualifier.
- Round 1 will be commanded, except for 7YO, Callers are permitted for round 2.
- Age for all horses will be as at 1 August, birth date must be indicated on entry form
  - 5 YO Championship for Horses—open to Horses born between 1-8-2016 and 31-7- 2017
  - 5 YO Championship for Horses—open to Horses born between 1-8-2015 and 31-7- 2016
  - 7 YO Championship for Horses—open to Horses born between 1-8-2014 and 31-7- 2015
  - 7 YO Championship for Horses—open to Horses born between 1-8-2013 and 31-7-2014
- All horses to be ridden in snaffle bridle, with the exception of 7 YO horses, who may be ridden in a snaffle or a double bridle.
- Whips permitted in all age groups.
- The mark from the second round will determine the final placings.

## Accreditation & Ticketing

General admission passes will be allocated as follows: **One pass per rider, one pass per groom (one groom per horse), one pass for one registered EA horse owner.** This entitles the bearer to

free admittance to the venue and to the general seating stands at all times (see note below). Accreditation (in the form of wrist bands) will be issued at the venue to riders, owner and grooms.

- **There will be strict control on the issue of wrist bands issued during the event.**
- **No additional passes** will be allocated for horses owned by multiple owners or syndicates unless approved by the Event Director/s.

## Stabling

- Stabling is to be booked online whilst doing online entries on the Willinga Park entry system.
- Stable costs see table below.
- All stables have rubber flooring. 4 x bales of Shavings are included with booking. Extra bedding can be purchased at the venue or purchase with entries.
- Stables left unclean on departure will incur a \$75 cleaning fee, this will be charged post event to the credit card used for entries.
- Tack Rooms: are not available at this event.
- No temporary yards of any kind are allowed.
- Please note: Charges for stable hire at Willinga Park applies to hire per event or both events. There is no per night fee available.

- Arrival of Horses: Willinga Park will be open for arrival of horses from midday Wednesday, 17 February for the first event. If arriving for the 2<sup>nd</sup> event only, please do not arrive until 4pm Tuesday 23 February.

## Camping & Catering

- **Camping facilities:** These are available on the grounds. Powered sites are available and must be booked at time of entry. There are excellent shower and toilet facilities with hot and cold water. All toilets and showers are unisex. There are amazing rider facilities including a swimming pool, BBQ area, washing machines and dryers. **All camping vehicles must have an approved lead connecting to power outlets.**

## Accommodation

- Luxury onsite pavilions immediately adjacent to the stables are made exclusively to event attendees and competitors. Book with online entries.

## General Information

- **Prize money:** Prize money will be credited to competitors/owners within approx. 10 working days after the event via Electronic Funds Transfer. **Please ensure you enter correct bank details on the entry.**
- **Dogs** – Willinga Park does allow dogs, but they must be on a lead and in the care of a responsible person at all times. Please clean up after your dog, & **no dangerous dogs**. Fines will apply for non-compliance (\$120 for the first offence, 2<sup>nd</sup> offence owners will be asked to remove their dog from the venue).
- **Transport:** There is no public transport to the venue.



- **Exercise and Warm Up Area:** Warm-up/ training arenas are available for use prior to competition. More information will be contained in the entry confirmation letter sent to riders.
- Willinga Park Merchandise can be purchased at the venue.
- **Indemnity:** Neither the Organising Committee (Willinga Park) or Equestrian Australia, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, grooms, owners, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. All competitors, in entering, undertake to accept this regulation.
- **Insurances:** The OC (Willinga Park) has public liability insurance through Equestrian Australia (EA). AUS competitors have some personal accident and public liability insurance as part of their membership of Equestrian Australia.
- All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are, therefore, strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

## Welfare of the Horse – FEI Code of Conduct

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery, tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they will be allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

## Vaccinations & Biosecurity

- **Vaccinations:** We recommend that horses are vaccinated for Hendra virus, in particular those that reside in high risk Hendra areas. We also recommend horse vaccinations for Strangles and Tetanus are up to date
- **Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration:** Must be handed in upon arrival when checking in.
